Michelangelo Merisi da Caravaggio 1571-1610 has long been recognized as one of the great innovators in the history of art through detailed analysis of paintings from his early Roman period 1594-1602 this study now situates his art firmly within both its humanistic and its scientific context here both his revolutionary painterly techniques pronounced naturalism and dramatic chiaroscuro and his novel subject matter still life compositions and genre scenes are finally put into their proper cultural and contemporary environment this environment included the contemporary rise of empirical scientific observation a procedure like Caravaggio's naturalism committed to a close study of the phenomenal world it also included the interests of his erudite aristocratic patrons influential Romans whose tastes reflected the Renaissance commitment to humanistic studies emblematic literature and classical lore the historical evidence entered into the record here includes both contemporary writings addressing the instructive purposes of art and the ancient literary sources commonly manipulated in Caravaggio's time that sanctioned a socially realistic art the overall result of this investigation is to characterize the work of the painter as an expression of learned naturalism

how machiavelli s christianity shaped his political thought to many readers of the prince machiavelli appears to be deeply un christian or even anti christian a cynic who thinks rulers should use religion only to keep their subjects in check but in machiavelli s god maurizio viroli one of the world s leading authorities on machiavelli argues that machiavelli far from opposing christianity thought it was crucial to republican social and political renewal but that first it needed to be renewed itself and without understanding this viroli contends it is impossible to comprehend machiavelli s thought viroli places machiavelli in the context of florence s republican christianity which was founded on the idea that the true christian is a citizen who serves the common good in this tradition god participates in human affairs supports and rewards those who govern justly and desires men to make the earthly city similar to the divine one building on this tradition machiavelli advocated a religion of virtue and he believed that without this faith free republics could not be established defend themselves against corruption or survive viroli makes a powerful case that machiavelli far from being a pagan or atheist was a prophet of a true religion of liberty a way of moral and political living that would rediscover and pursue charity and justice the translation of this work has been funded by seps segretariato europeo per le pubblicazioni scientifiche

their provocative manifestos and outrageous performances earned the italian futurists international fame but surprisingly very little recognition outside of italy for their actual achievements the few english and american critics who have studied the movement in any

depth have focused on the first phase which spanned the years 1909-15 and was centred in Milan, Rome and Florence. By contrast the second phase covered a much longer period and represented a pan-Italian phenomenon. Despite the wealth of material available about this later part of the movement there has been little attempt to survey futurist activity outside of the major geographical centres in any detail or to relate it to the futurist mainstream. In the other *Futurism* Willard Bohn seeks to remedy this oversight by examining the work of futurists in Venice, Padua and Verona from 1909 to 1944. He considers these local artists and writers both in terms of their relationship with F. T. Marinetti who remained the major theorist and organizer of futurist activities and of their own specific adaptations and appropriations of futurist theory. Conceived as a combination literary history and critical study the other *Futurism* looks at particular examples of literature, visual arts and the performing arts and using a series of rare documents sheds new light on the complex cultural and political issues at the heart of this neglected chapter in Italy's history.

published in 1559 and appearing here for the first time in English. *La villa* is a rare source of Renaissance landscape theory written by Bartolomeo Taegio, a Milanese jurist and man of letters. After his banishment, possibly for murder, Thomas E. Beck speculates the text takes the form of a dialogue between two gentlemen, one a proponent of the country, the other of the city. While it is not a gardening treatise, *La villa* reflects an aesthetic appreciation of the land. In the Renaissance reveals the symbolic and metaphorical significance of sixteenth-century gardens for their owners and articulates a specific philosophy about the interaction of nature and culture in the garden.
